The path to becoming a CMA starts with the completion of **16 CMA Required Topics**. By completing the courses listed above (for the Bachelor of Commerce Program), UTM students who graduate and achieve a minimum mark of 60% in each CMA required course will be eligible to write the CMA Entrance Exam upon graduation. After passing the **4-hour CMA Entrance Exam** (min. 60%), CMA Candidates will then complete the **2-year, part-time Strategic Leadership Program** and accumulate **24 months** of relevant **CMA Practical Experience**. Practical experience can be obtained in a wide variety of positions across all industry sectors (may include some public acct'g work) but must reflect the CMA Competency Map. Throughout the CMA program, candidates will dynamically integrate the three critical pillars of **Accounting, Management & Strategy** and will develop both the functional and enabling competencies that will transform them into a strategic, financial management professional.

The **CMA Accelerated Program is an alternate path for students** (Commerce, BBA or other programs) **who are unable to complete all 16 CMA Required Topics before graduation**. " \* " indicates the courses required to qualify for the CMA Accelerated Program. By obtaining your degree and at least 60% in these four CMA topics, you will be eligible to complete this **7-month, part-time, bridging program in order to fully qualify for the CMA Entrance Exam**. (The Accelerated Program starts each Sept. and Jan. Visit [www.cma-ontario.org/accelerated](http://www.cma-ontario.org/accelerated) for more information.)  
NOTE: Students/graduates who are missing any CMA Topics can also complete them through part-time study.
